Windridge Landing has developed a new **Welcoming Committee**. This committee will contact and welcome new homeowners as they move into our community.

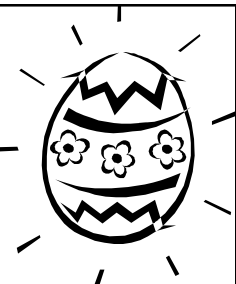

What's New in Brownsburg Schools

New Hepatitis B Vaccination Requirement— Effective July 1– July 2008, every child who enters grade 9 and 12 will be required to be immunized against Hepatitis B infections. Usually three shots are required to complete the Hepatitis B vaccination series. While the Indiana State Department of Health has re-

quired this immunization for all students entering kindergarten and first grade over the past several years, there may be older

students who have not received the vaccination series. Please consult your family phy-

sician to ensure your children have been vaccinated. The Hepatitis B

vaccination is also available at the local health department for a cost of fifty cents per shot. To schedule an appointment, you can call the Hendricks County Health Department at 745-9222.
